Practical Details: 3 Day Conference

Background

Unfortunately, the 13th IIF Conference will not occur physically in Medan, Indonesia due to the COVID-19 outbreak. Instead, we have successfully adopted a mixed format: physical and virtual.

The actual date of the 13th IIF Conference remained as planned. The conference will take place on 24-26 August, 2020 and now be 3 days long (extended by 1 day). Please see the online program for details.

Day 1 will be a mixed format held in National Cheng Kung University (Taiwan) with online streaming of the proceedings and online participation and online presentations also included.

Day 2 and **Day 3** will be purely online with online participation and presentations.

The planned cooperation with Universitas Katolik Santo Thomas for IIF 13 is maintained but the National Cheng Kung University (Taiwan) has graciously allowed the use of its physical facilities to become the physical host for day 1 of the conference. The risk for COVID-19 continues to be very minimal in Taiwan.

Academic Matters

- The conference is designed to provide opportunities for speakers both from Indonesia and beyond to join with colleagues and share their ideas and research into the central theme of the conference in a multidisciplinary setting. Every speaker is expected to bring his or her academic and personal expertise to the mix.
- As this is an international forum, the language of the conference is English. We encourage

those with a range of proficiency in the language to participate.

- All presentations are 20 minutes plus 10 minutes for questions. We expect all presenters to strictly respect this time schedule.
- Because of the online format there are no parallel sessions this year but the conference will for the first time last 3 full days. The speakers will be grouped into matching sub-panels on different aspects of the central theme, to be determined by the committee.
- The use of PowerPoint is considered helpful but not obligatory.
- During the selection procedure, all abstracts are considered anonymously by the committee.
- Except in exceptional circumstances, all presenters are expected to hold a Master's degree or higher.

Financial Matters and Accommodation

- Participants To be determined by the host university.
- Speakers: There are no conference fees for speakers, with physical facilities being generously provided by National Cheng Kung University and virtual cooperation by Universitas Katolik Santo Thomas (Indonesia). Unfortunately, this also means that there will be no remunerations or subsidies of any kind. Speakers are advised to make their own arrangements regarding accommodations.

Publication Matters

For publication of the papers, the IIF continues to cooperate with the peer-reviewed: *Nusantara: An International Journal of Humanities and Social Sciences* and the Center for Multi-cultural Studies, NCKU.

Venue on Day 1

- The host university will determine the exact location of the conference rooms and will update the conference brochure accordingly: The venue for Day 1: Cheng-Chi Lecture Hall, Department of History, NCKU, Tainan, Taiwan.
- Speakers are expected to make their own arrangements for transportation to the conference.
